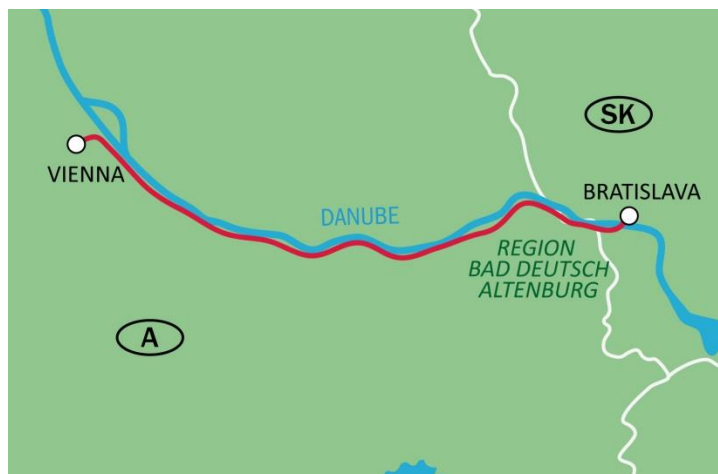


Danube Cycle Path

Vienna – Bratislava | in 3 days



Info

The Danube cycling path does not end up in Vienna! East of Vienna begins the fascinating landscape of the Pannonian Lowlands. The wonderful "Donauauen" National Park is host to one of the last primeval forests in Europe. Furthermore, the Slovakian capital Bratislava enchants its guests with a lovely restored old city centre and numerous intriguing sights.

Reiseverlauf

1. Day: Vienna – Region Bad Deutsch Altenburg, approx. 46 km

The Danube cycling path leads you on peaceful path through the "Donauauen" National Park through the former Roman city Petronell-Carnuntum until the health resort town Bad Deutsch Altenburg. The vineyards of Carnuntum offer you countless delights.

2. Day: Region Bad Deutsch Altenburg – Bratislava, approx. 21 km

After a short ride you reach the border city Hainburg. Through an impressive natural landscape you ride directly into the city of Bratislava.

3. Day: Bratislava

Included bus from Bratislava to Vienna. Schedule more often a day, also stops at the airport Schwechat. Duration: approx. 1:20 hour

General information

- All bike tours are unescorted
- The mileages and approximations are distances of the recommended routes
- Please be prepared by packing all necessary items, for example, proper rain gear (jacket and pants), sun hat, sunscreen and proper sport shoes
- Arrival and departure to and from Vienna is a personal obligation not included in tour price
- In Slovakia you must wear a helmet by law outside of city limits!
- This cycling tour is not suitable for people with limited mobility. Individual requests are in special cases possible (f.e. handicapped accessible room)

Tour profile

Level 1; Paths are paved and mostly flat. Upon entering and leaving cities there is, but of course, traffic that must be closely observed!

4* hotel in Bratislava and middle-range hotel

Arrivals every Saturday, Sunday and Monday

Rental bikes & equipment

- 7-speed bikes with back pedal brake or 21-speed bikes (Unisex)
- Children's bikes, specialized equipment for children upon request.

All rental bikes are equipped with a pannier (saddle bag) and an odometer.

Parking

- Public parking places: unguarded, free of charge, directly behind the hotel
- Public parking garage = Park & Ride: approx. 18,30 EUR per week, unguarded, at the underground/metro station Leopoldau

Included services

- 2 nights in rooms with private facilities
- Breakfast or dinner (surcharge)
- Daily luggage transport up to hotel in Bratislava (max. 2 pieces of luggage (max. 20kg/piece) with max. 30 kg/Person)
- Return transfer by public bus from Bratislava to Vienna, departure at 2.00 p.m.
- Service-hotline (also accessible on weekends)
- Handlebar bag with maps and information material per room

Reduction

Reduction with 2 full paying adults in double room (additional bed):

0-6,99 years	-100%
7-11,99 years	-50%
12-14,99 years	-25%
15-99 years	-10%

In Austria it is mandatory for children under 12 yrs to wear a helmet when on a bike. In Slovakia you have to wear a helmet by law outside of city limits!

Additional charge*

- Bike helmet – payable locally € 29
- Reduction for „no bus“ € (price will follow)
- Return transfer Bratislava-Vienna by hydrofoil / Price depends on the schedule time (own bike included / limited space, reservation in advance)
